AGENCY SUMMARY:

- 2,174 Hotline Calls** (1,953 victims of domestic violence; 221 sexual assault) *[last year 2,324 total]*
- 7,520 Volunteer hours** (5,838 Direct Services; 1,682 Other hrs) *[last year 7,933 total]*
- 897 Participants** (745 women, 144 children, and 8 men) *[last year 854 total]*
- 11,005 Bed Nights** (6,650 Shelter bednights; 4,355 TLP bednights) *[last year 8,680 total]* –
- 6,747 units of additional Support Services** (2,198 units to residents, 3,558 units to non-residents, and 991 units to TLP participants) *[last year 7,417 total]*

The Shelter provided **670** non-resident program participants (662 female and 8 male) with **3,558** hours of service including the following: *[last year 650 for 2,921 hours total]*

- ◆ **291** hours of Crisis Intervention services *[last year 298 total]*
 - ◆ **723** hours of Case Management services (**362** hours of Domestic Violence or Sexual Assault Education, **87** hours of Safety Planning, **27** hours of Financial Assistance, and **247** hours of general Case Management working on housing, employment, child care, and other issues) *[last year 575 total]*
 - ◆ **5** Parenting Sessions and/or Child Education Sessions *[last year 8 total]*
 - ◆ **670** hours of Court Advocacy including assistance with **258** Ex Parte Orders of Protection, **101** Full Orders of Protection, and **1** Child Ex Parte Order of Protection. *[last year 563 total]*
 - ◆ **166** hours of Hospital Advocacy. *[last year 163 total]*
 - ◆ **818** Counseling Sessions *[last year 669 total]*
 - ◆ **167** Support Group Sessions for **251** hours (127 domestic violence & 40 sexual assault victim support groups) with an average of 6 individuals attending each. *[last year 163 total]*
 - ◆ **61** Batterer Intervention Groups for **92** hours of service (groups are co-facilitated by Shelter and Family Counseling staff). *[last year 64 total]*
 - ◆ **292** hours of Victim Advocacy *[last year 292 total]*
- **114** Non residents were victims of sexual assault provided with **517** hours of service. *[last year 113 Non-residents were provided with 488 hrs of service]*
- Average age of non-residents was **29 years**; *[last year 32 years]*
- Average number of services provided to each participant was **5.31** *[last year 4.48 hours]*
